Charitable Grant Application Form (cont'd.)

In General

These limited grants are intended for local/district Masonic organizations that are not supported primarily through the umbrella of the Masonic Brotherhood Foundation, or supported otherwise by or through the Grand Lodge. Grants will be based on demonstrated need.

No grant will exceed \$10,000. If this is not sufficient for the purpose of the project, please explain how the remainder of the work will be financed. The Foundation reserves the right to disburse the grant monies in stages, when appropriate, to allow for review of the various components of the work being done.

As noted above, grants from the Masonic Brotherhood Foundation may only be made to 501(c)3 tax exempt organizations. For the Masonic Brotherhood Foundation to consider a grant application, the application must be accompanied by the organization's most recent IRS 990 filing, along with a copy of its current IRS 501(c)3 designation. Applicants must also submit a copy of the requesting organization's current budget, financials and a narrative detailing the charitable work it has supported over the prior twelve months.

The number of grants is limited, so the applications should be submitted as quickly as possible. Applicants should consider this round of project grants to be one-time awards only.

The Foundation Board may have questions about the application and will reach out to the designated Contact Person and/or District Deputy Grand Master as needed. The Board reserves the right to revoke or terminate a grant.
